Test Content

- Know argumentation for Luke's authorship of Acts
- Recognize occasions and emphasis of the Great Commission
- Identify characteristics of biblical miracles
- Identify and locate the 28 major cities involved in the history of Acts

- Place the 42 significant characters of Acts into the proper chapters and narrative of Acts
- Relate the Pauline epistles to the history of Acts
- Know the chronological layout of Acts

- Apply proper interpretation of tongues, baptismal regeneration, infant baptism, communal living, legalism, church offices, and the Sabbath
