Test Content

- Understand the theme of God's wrath with a particular emphasis upon the doctrines of condemnation and justification.
- Understand God's righteousness in justification.
- Understand the proof of justification by faith from the Scriptures based on Old Testament illustrations (Romans 4:1-25).
- Understand God's righteousness in sanctification.
- Compare God's righteousness in His relationship with Israel in terms of her rejection and His sovereignty.
- Be familiar with Israel's place in God's plan for the church including the concept of vindication.
- Know the principles of the Christian life which enable a believer to live out the Gospel day by day.
- Recognize a list of characteristics from Romans 13-16 which present Christian love in action.
