Test Content

Special attention is given to the development of American Christianity.
- Be familiar with the major events and great turning points in this period of Christian history.
- Be familiar enough with the history of the Christian church to be able successfully to answer general objective questions on exams dealing with events, personalities, and dates.
- Identify dates of major events and personalities in Christian history
- Identify the major movements which have been influential in changing the course of Christian history, such as the persecutions, the rise of heresy, and the rise of Roman Catholicism.
